Goals and core values of the Association "WOMEN IN TRANSPORT"




- cooperate with similar organizations in Latvia, EU member states and other countries, including to promote a common standard of good management practices in transport companies in different countries and modes of transport;
- to develop research and projects in the sector, to ensure the participation of women in research and the analysis of transport projects and a view from the perspective of women the needs of women as transport users;


- participate in the formation of industry policies, promote women's representation in decision-making processes at the international, national and local levels.




Association activity









Association founding meeting on August 18, 2020

On October 23, 2020, the first strategy conference organized by the Association "Women in Transport" was held, where women from various transport sectors agreed on the joint definition of guidelines for the further development of the strategy for achieving the association's goals.









The forum "Women's Career Opportunities in Passenger Transport: From Employee to Leader" on September 15, 2022, in the Great Hall of the Ministry of Transport and online.

Series of articles about members of the association "Women in Transport," and thei career in the aviation industry has been published on the portal Jauns.lv.









On October 27, 2023, the annual Forum organized by the association "Women in Transport" took place.

This year, the Forum was held during the European Gender Equality Week, celebrated across Europe including in the European Parliament — from October 23 to 29.

As part of Gender Equality Week, regional leaders and representatives of the transport sector are invited to come together and discuss the progress made and the upcoming challenges in the field of gender equality, particularly in the context of urban mobility.

The association "Women in Transport" is participating in a meeting with collaborative ideas related to the UNESCO International Day of Women and Girls in Science.

On December 5, 2024, the annual Forum organized by the association "Women in Transport" took place, focusing on the timely theme: "Well-being and Women in Transport."


The Forum was held in person at the Transport and Telecommunication Institute and was also broadcast online
